David Indiano Named to Plaintiffs' Steering Committee in Antitrust Class Action Lawsuit Against Shipping Companies

A class action lawsuit has been filed against various shipping companies that have conspired to fix prices for shipping goods to and from Puerto Rico. David Indiano has been named as one of the attorneys for the Plaintiffs' Steering Committee that is prosecuting this lawsuit. The case has been consolidated for discovery in the District of Puerto Rico by the Panel for Multidistrict Litigation and is styled as In Re: Puerto Rican Cabotage Antitrust Litigation; MDL 1960.

Recently, defendant Horizon agreed to pay \$20,000,000 in settlement for the claims against it. Litigation is continuing against the remaining defendants.

Besides this litigation, Indiano & Williams is also participating in other class actions involving antitrust allegations including In Re: Refrigerant Compressors Antitrust Litigation; MDL 2042 and In Re: Blood Reagents Antitrust Litigation; MDL 2081.
