

Indiano and Williams PSC recovers compensation for parents and child after child is injured from a fall at a fast food restaurant playground.

A lawsuit was filed on behalf of the family when bubble door opened while child was playing inside hamster cage-like structure, resulting in a neck and back injury. As a result of poor maintenance of play equipment, a hatch or door was left unfastened and unlocked. Failure of periodic inspections of equipment and absent playground supervision lead to this dangerous condition which eventually caused the child to fall out hitting her head, neck and shoulder which resulted in chronic back problems.
