

Indiano & Williams PSC recovers for death of patient after filing medical malpractice and EMTALA actions.

Recovery for family is obtained after a legal action was filed under medical malpractice and EMTALA theories against hospital A that accepted a CVA (cardiovascular accident) patient in need of head computerized tomography (ct scan) which had been non functional for days. Patient was transported by hospital A in an ill-equipped ambulance to hospital B. Hospital B conducted the ct scan but improperly returned him by ambulance without ensuring stabilization. The ambulance service was also sued for not having the necessary equipment and/or qualified personnel to handle this patient and for taking this unstable patient from hospital B where ct scan was conducted.
